

No-Paint Waterfall

What you'll need:

- boxes (9-12 in a variety of sizes ranging from 9"x12" all the way up to 2'x3' depending how big you want to make your waterfall)
- Cool Connectors*
- packing tape
- roll of gray paper
- Water Fabric*
- Gleam 'N' Curtain- Blue*
- greenery
- flowers
- paper rocks (see separate instructions)
- rainforest stuffed animals (such as the Rainforest Flyers*)

What you'll do:

Step 1: Build and stack boxes together to create a tower that is wide at the bottom and narrower at the top. We used Cool Connectors and tape to connect our boxes to each other.

Step 2: Add boxes at the bottom of the tower to create steps so the tower has a cascading effect.

Step 3: Cover the tower with gray crumpled paper. Press Cool Connectors through the paper and the box.

Step 4: Add paper to the sides and edges to for a rough, rocky look.

Step 5: Tape Water Fabric to the top of the box tower and allow the fabric to cascade down.

Step 6: To make a pool at the bottom of the waterfall, shape Water Fabric in an oval. Place paper rocks around the edge of the fabric.

Step 7: Add blue Gleam 'N' Curtain over the top of the Water Fabric.

Step 8: Decorate the waterfall with greenery, flowers, and rainforest stuffed animals.
