

# Rope Ladder

## What you'll need:

- rope
- scissors
- measuring tape
- hot glue
- masking tape or lighter

## What you'll do:

**Step 1:** Measure and cut two lengths of rope each  $5\frac{1}{2}'$  long.

**Step 2:** Measure and cut four lengths of rope each  $1'$  long. Tape or burn the ends to keep them from fraying.

**Step 3:** Take one of the  $5\frac{1}{2}'$  lengths and measure down  $1'$ , then tie a knot, then measure down  $1'$ , then tie a knot. Continue this process until you have four knots tied  $1'$  apart from each other. The finished length should be about  $4\frac{1}{2}'$ . Do this to the other  $5\frac{1}{2}'$  section as well.

**Step 4:** Lay the long knotted ropes parallel to each other. Glue a  $1'$  length so that it spans from the first knot of one rope to the first knot of the other rope. Repeat this process at each knot.
